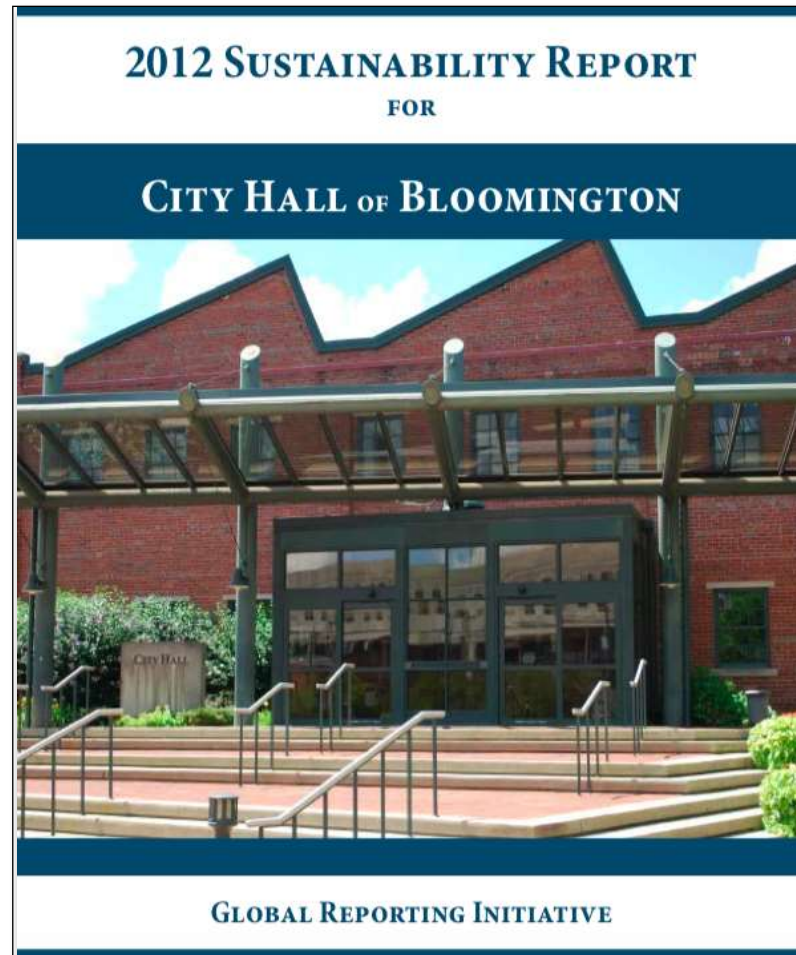

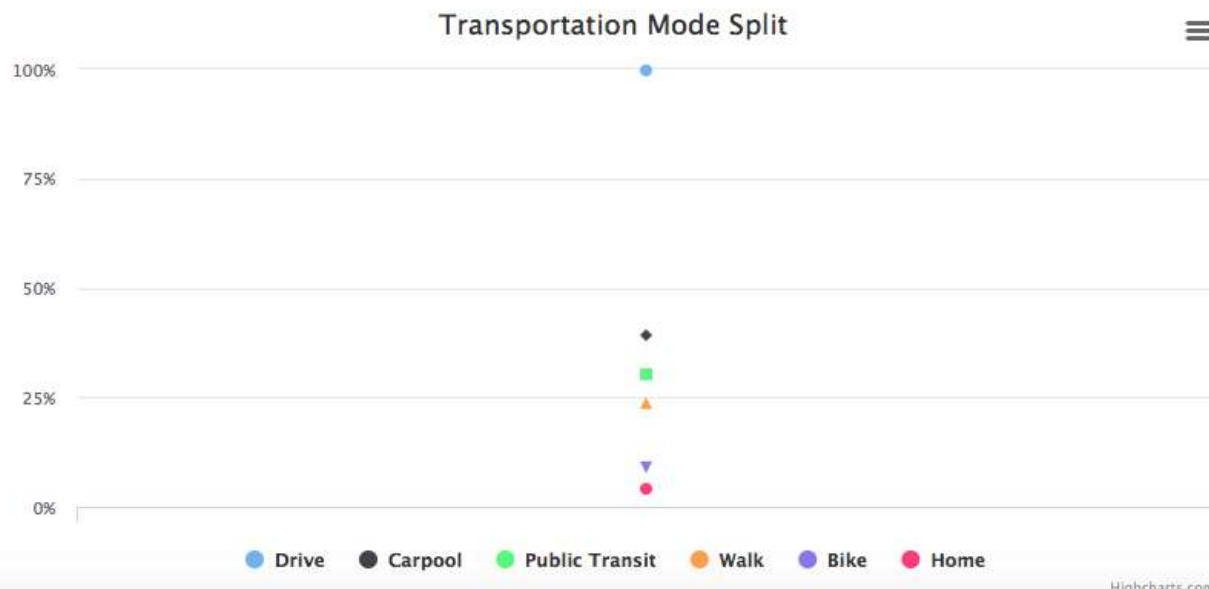

Bloomington is very proud of our mode split, and we continue to work to encourage residents to use active transportation rather than single occupancy vehicles. Our Civil Streets program focuses on the central message that "Courtesy is Contagious," and encourages all users of our streets to treat each other with caution and respect. We have invested significantly in bike and ped infrastructure, increasing our mileage of bike infrastructure from 16 miles to 63 miles since 2001, and aim to be a Platinum bike-friendly community.
